The newly developed APS Minority Initiative awards present a special opportunity for minority students, fellows, interns, residents or post-docs to attend the 70th Annual Scientific Conference of the American Psychosomatic Society which will be held in Athens, Greece from March 14-17, 2012. Applicant must be an underrepresented minority as defined by the NIH to be African-Americans, Hispanics, Native-Americans and Alaska Natives, and Pacific Islanders. If you have won this award in the past, you are not eligible to win again, so please do not submit an application.

Each award will include travel funds to assist in attending the meeting, and a complimentary meeting registration. The deadline to be considered for one of these awards is **November 1, 2011**.
